

Big Splash Rules



Please review the following rules with your group before they arrive at Big Splash Adventure.

A good time to do this is on the bus in the parking lot just before they enter the facility.

- The number one rule is **NO RUNNING!**
- Buccaneer Bay (structure with the dumping bucket) has two slides; remember to use the slides one at a time making sure the rider at the bottom is out of the flume BEFORE you go down.
- **Hot tub is for ADULTS (18+) only!!**
- Wading pool with the yellow swings and the baby slide are for our infants and toddlers only.
- Indoor and outdoor leisure pools with the basketball goals are areas for swimming. Use the balls for the basketball goals, do not play dodge ball or try to hit anyone in the head. Please do not hang on the basketball rims. Do not jump or dive in. At the lily pads, form a line at the enter point of the lily pads to cross using the rope. Once you fall off, exit the area immediately using the ladder. You may not swim near the lily pads. You must go one at a time and do not go until the person ahead of you is almost across the other side.
- Slide tower has four slides. Two are inner tube slides that you may ride single or double. You must take a tube up the tower to the slides. There are two body slides that you may ride on your back with your hands and feet crossed. Wait for the lifeguard to tell you when it is safe to go. The blue body slide spits you out into the plunge area of our Lazy River. The water is almost five feet deep so be prepared, you may go under water for a moment.
- Our Lazy River is where you will get a tube and float on it. You may not swim or get off your tube. It is a lazy river so no horseplay or standing on your tubes or forming chains by holding on to other tubes. Please use the stairs to enter and exit the river. Do not jump in off the side.

If you are less than 46" tall you must wear a lifejacket in the Lazy River, the indoor and *outdoor leisure pools and if you ride the red tube slide that spits you out into the river.

Have a great day and play safe. The lifeguards will help remind you of all the rules and measure you if and when you need a lifejacket.
